

NON-PERISHABLES may be dropped in the AJH bin in the Bell Tower (open M-F, 7a-3p) any time BEFORE the WEDNESDAY preceding the SECOND THURSDAY of the month.

VOLUNTEERS are also needed to SERVE the FHC lunch on that SECOND THURSDAY of each month. Volunteers are asked to be at AJH from 11:15 to 2:30 to help with set-up, lunch, and clean-up. Lunch is served 12-2. Each server is asked to bring 2-3 gallons of whole or 2% milk. Please use the SignUp below to volunteer.

The next donation date is WEDNESDAY, February 7, for the lunch that will be served on THURSDAY, February 8. AJH also runs a pantry, providing food to 75-125 households every week. Donations of NON-PERISHABLE ITEMS such as canned chicken and tuna, peanut butter. cereal, rice, pasta, canned tomato products, vegetables, and soups, kosher food, and low-sodium food, are ALWAYS welcome.
