If you know now that you will be away on that week-end, please bring your donations earlier and help to fill the east side confessional. Blue food pantry envelopes can be put in the collection basket any time.

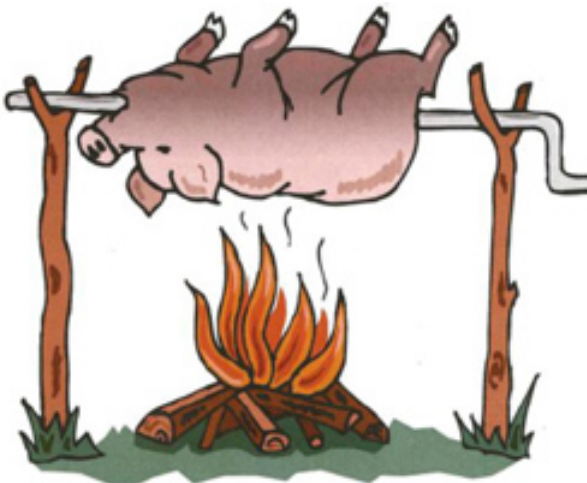

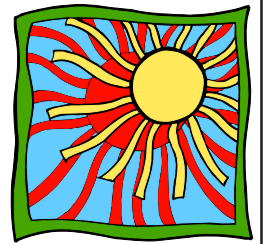

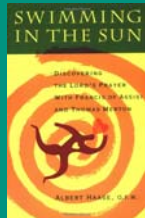
