


Who Says That?

- 3. I am the head of a number of parishes, called a diocese. I serve the community as the spiritual leader of my diocese.
- 4. I am not a priest, but I serve the community as an ordained minister. I preach, assist at Mass, baptize, witness marriages, and serve the needs of the community.
- 5. I am part of the episcopal college. I help the pope guide the Church.
- 6. My title comes from the Greek word presbyter, which means "elder."
