



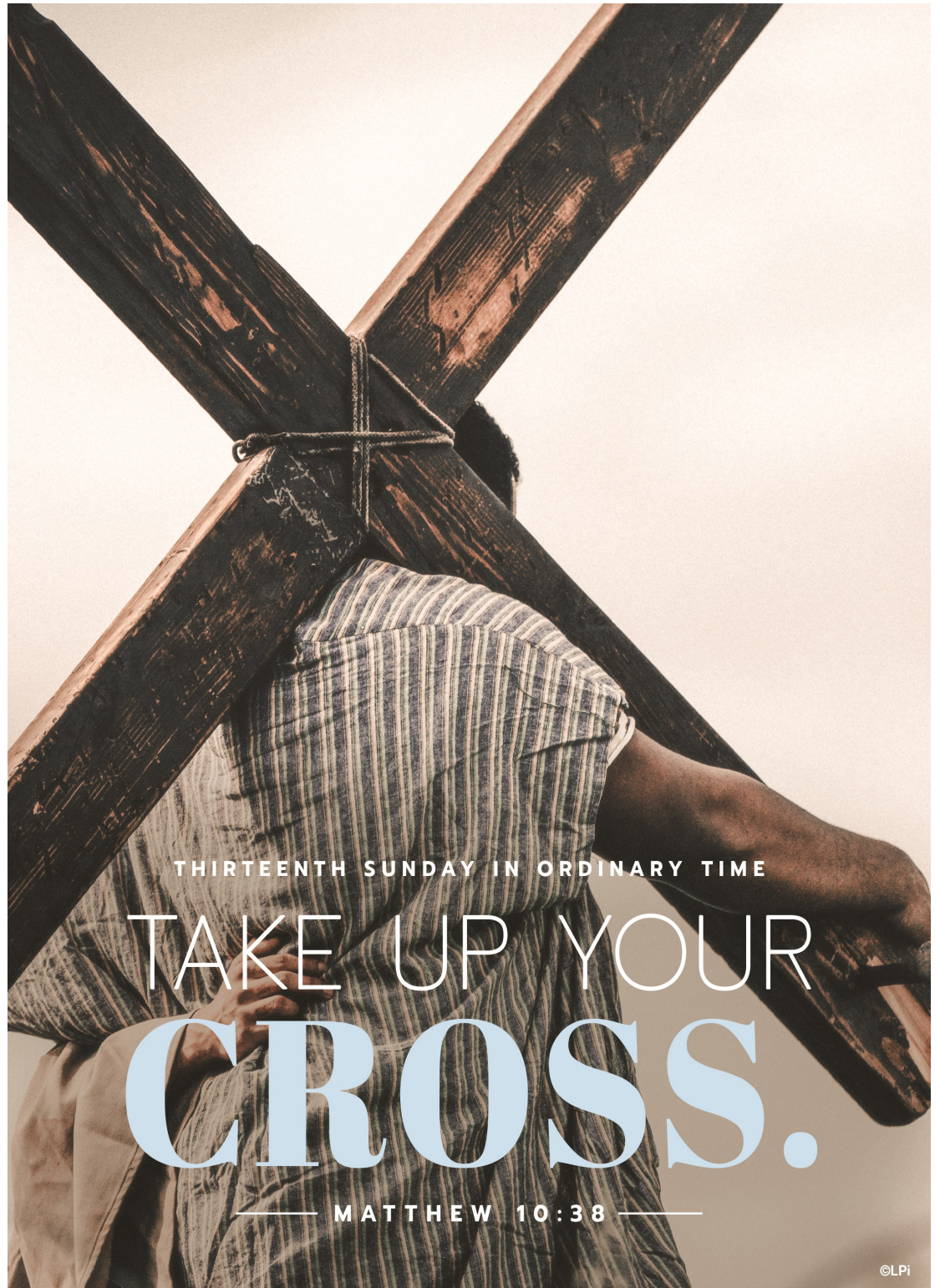

A Just Harvest serves a hot lunch every day. FHC donates the meal served on the **SECOND THURSDAY** of each month. Please use the SignUp below to sign up for **FOOD DONATIONS**.

NON-PERISHABLES may be dropped in the **AJH bin in the back of church** (open daily 7a-12p) any time **BEFORE** the **WEDNESDAY** preceding the **SECOND THURSDAY** of the month. **PERISHABLES MUST BE LEFT in the bin ON THAT WEDNESDAY BY 7:30am** to ensure they're usable when delivered that morning to the AJH kitchen.

VOLUNTEERS are also needed to **SERVE** the FHC lunch on that **SECOND THURSDAY** of each month. Volunteers are asked to be at AJH from **11:15 to 2:30** to help with set-up, lunch, and clean-up. Lunch is served 12-2. Each server is asked to bring 2-3 gallons of whole or 2% milk. **Servers should wear closed-toe shoes and slacks or jeans (no shorts or skirts please)**. Please use the SignUp below to volunteer to serve.

The next donation date is **WEDNESDAY, July 8**, for the lunch that will be served on **THURSDAY, July 9**.

AJH also runs a pantry, providing food to roughly 175 households every week. Donations of **NON-PERISHABLES** are always welcome and may be put in the bin. Suggested: canned chicken, tuna, fruit and vegetables; cereal, rice, pasta.

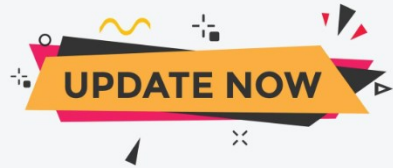

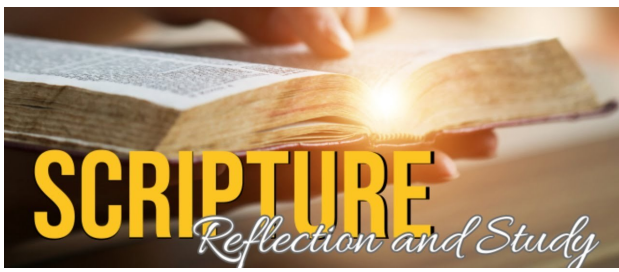

Scripture Reflection Lead by Deacon Michael and Jean Cavanaugh on Zoom Wednesday Mornings

We dive into the readings for whatever Sunday is next. We are welcome to express confusion or skepticism arising from thoughtful encounters with the readings. What we learn from sharing these questions is illuminating, even surprising.

We utilize the critical/historical approach advanced by Fr. Donald Senior, CP, taught at the Chicago Theological Union and published in The Jerome Biblical Commentary for the 21st Century.

There is no charge for this, in contrast to its value in expanding our faith. On Zoom, Wednesday mornings at 9 AM. It's a time you can share with a family member or friend anywhere in the world.

School Boiler Replacement Project – This Summer

We are pleased to share that this summer we will be replacing all three boilers that heat the school and pre-school – a significant and necessary investment in our facilities.



Of our three existing units, one has been out of service for more than a year, and the remaining two have exceeded their lifespan. Replacing all three at once allows us to restore full heating capacity to the school while avoiding the higher costs of staggered replacements down the road.

Work is expected to take place over the summer months, and we anticipate minimal disruption to normal parish activities. However, please be aware that a small number of parking spaces near the gym may be temporarily unavailable during portions of the project. We appreciate your patience and flexibility.

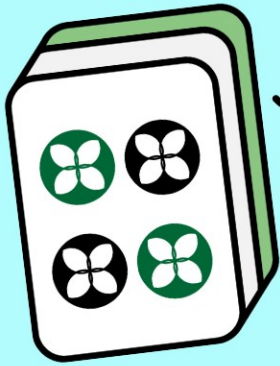

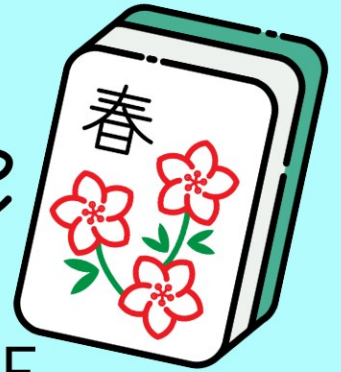
The one-time training is conveniently-scheduled, and you may choose your Mass and frequency of service.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

I still remember the first homily I ever preached as a new deacon. It was at the seminary, and the Gospel was this one: “Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me.” (Matthew 10:37-38) Standing before more than 200 classmates and professors, I stumbled awkwardly through my words and realized how strange – almost insane – this teaching sounded. If anyone else said it, we would call it narcissistic or cultish.

And that is the point. I felt the weight of those words in my own heart then, as I still do today. Am I willing to live as though Christ’s claim on my love is absolute? Are you?

Over the years, I’ve learned that the more I do, the more everything else makes sense. Family, friendships, vocation, even my very self: all of it falls into place when my love for Jesus comes first.

That is why he dares to speak this way. Our Lord is not a cult leader hungry for control. He is the Son of God, the source of life and love itself. To put him before everything else is not to lose, but to find...everything, and everyone, in him.

This week, name one thing or one person you are tempted to place before the Lord. Then consciously offer it back to him in prayer.
