



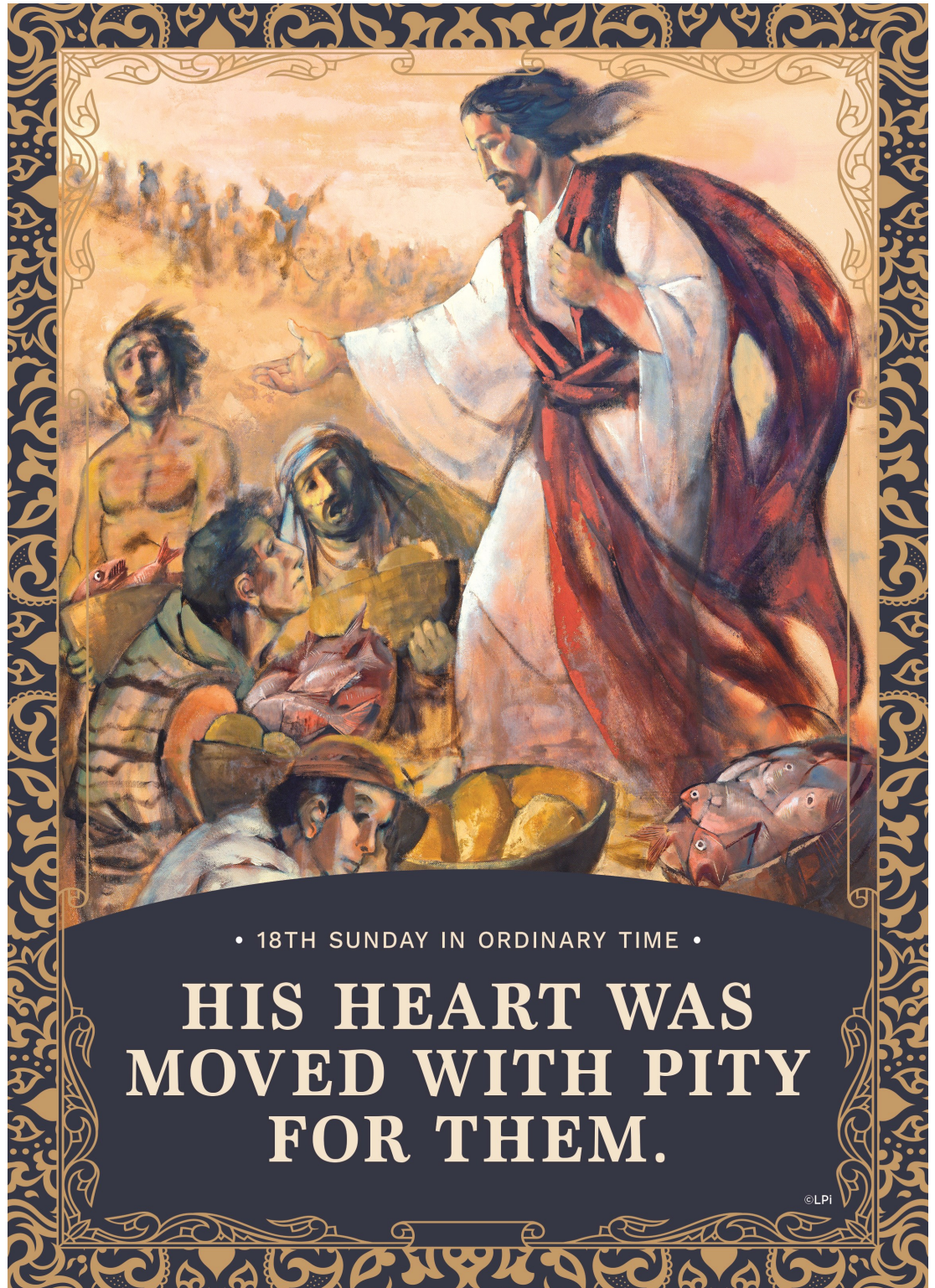

A Just Harvest serves a hot lunch every day. FHC donates the meal served on the **SECOND THURSDAY** of each month. Please use the SignUp below to sign up for **FOOD DONATIONS**.

NON-PERISHABLES may be dropped in the **AJH bin in the back of church** (open daily 7a-12p) any time **BEFORE** the **WEDNESDAY** preceding the **SECOND THURSDAY** of the month. **PERISHABLES MUST BE LEFT in the bin ON THAT WEDNESDAY BY 7:30am** to ensure they're usable when delivered that morning to the AJH kitchen.

VOLUNTEERS are also needed to **SERVE** the FHC lunch on that **SECOND THURSDAY** of each month. Volunteers are asked to be at AJH from 11:15 to 2:30 to help with set-up, lunch, and clean-up. Lunch is served 12-2. Each server is asked to bring 2-3 gallons of whole or 2% milk. **Servers should wear closed-toe shoes and slacks or jeans (no shorts or skirts please)**. Please use the SignUp below to volunteer to serve.

The next donation date is **WEDNESDAY, August 12**, for the lunch that will be served on **THURSDAY, August 13**.

AJH also runs a pantry, providing food to roughly 175 households every week. Donations of NON-PERISHABLES are always welcome and may be put in the bin. Suggested: canned chicken, tuna, fruit and vegetables; cereal, rice, pasta.

Dear Parishioner,

For those interested, the OCIA (the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, *formerly RCIA*) is beginning this Fall. OCIA is designed for those who are considering joining the Catholic Church through celebrating the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) at the Easter Vigil. The process welcomes adults who have never been baptized, those who have been baptized in another Christian tradition, or baptized Catholics who have not received Eucharist or Confirmation.

The OCIA process gathers adults to talk about faith in the light of our Roman Catholic tradition. The goal is to welcome people to our Church community at Easter time. We will meet on a weekly basis beginning Tuesday, September 15 at 7pm, with time off around Christmas. The traditional time to welcome new members to the Church is at Easter. REGISTER FOR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION FOR GRADES K-8

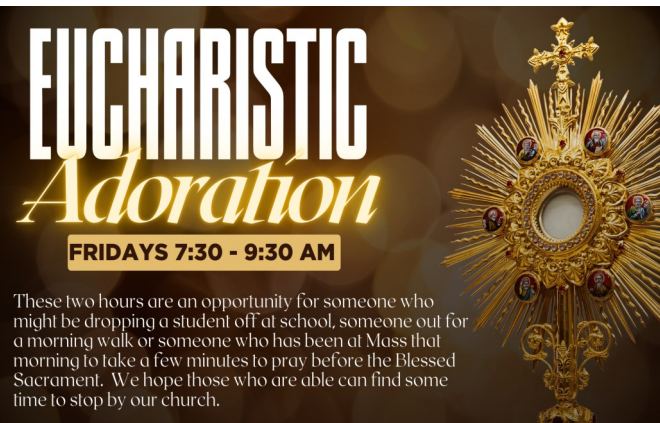

School Boiler Replacement Project – This Summer



We are pleased to share that this summer we will be replacing all three boilers that heat the school and pre-school – a significant and necessary investment in our facilities.

Of our three existing units, one has been out of service for more than a year, and the remaining two have exceeded their lifespan. Replacing all three at once allows us to restore full heating capacity to the school while avoiding the higher costs of staggered replacements down the road.

Work is expected to take place over the summer months, and we anticipate minimal disruption to normal parish activities. However, please be aware that a small number of parking spaces near the gym may be temporarily unavailable during portions of the project. We appreciate your patience and flexibility.

More details will be shared as the project gets underway.

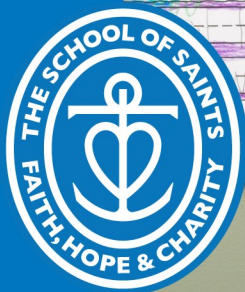

GOSPEL MEDITATION

In his song, “Lose Yourself,” the artist Eminem raps, “the mood all changed.”

We all know that moment when the mood changes, when life turns from lighthearted to deadly serious. That happens in today’s Gospel. Jesus has just heard that John the Baptist, his cousin, forerunner, and friend, has been murdered. As Matthew tells us, “When Jesus heard of it, he withdrew in a boat to a deserted place by himself.” Until now, he had been teaching in parables and healing quietly. But John’s death signals a new phase. The shadow of the Cross begins to fall. Evil shows its teeth.

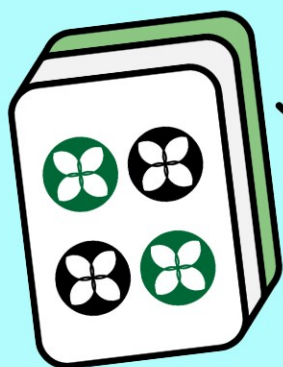
And how does Jesus respond? Not with rage or despair. He goes to a lonely place to go into deep communion with his Father. From that silence comes action. He feeds the multitude. Out of grief comes generosity. Out of sorrow, life.

This is the rhythm of every disciple’s life. When tragedy or violence breaks our hearts, we face a choice. We can react, or we can retreat into prayer — like and with Christ. This is the hidden place where pain becomes compassion and compassion becomes self-gift.

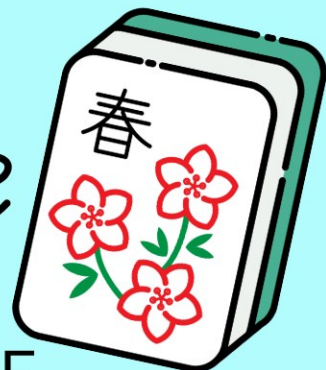

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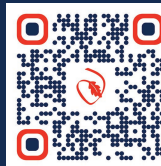
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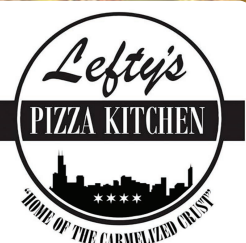
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
